Introduction and components

1. Unpack in the room the bed is intended to be used, remove all packaging and dispose of carefully, keeping polythene out of the reach of children.

- 3 x Fixing Nuts
- 3 x Fixing Bolts

- 4 x Allen Key Bolts

SAFETY FEATURES:

Your bed is fitted with a child lock on the button controler on the side. Activating the child lock will prevent the base lifting when the buttons are pressed. our bed will be delivered and installed with the child lock activated, you will need to de-activate the lock before using for the first time.



DANGER - RISK OF INJURY / CRUSHING

The ottoman must only be operated by responsible and capable adults.

Never allow children to operate the ottoman. Always engage the child safety lock when the ottoman is not in use.

To activate Child Lock;

press small hole with pointed object (like the sort of thing you'd remove a sim card from your mobile phone with)

Once **activated** the Green Light will turn off.

Turn off the Child Lock by repeating this step.





TOOLS REQUIRED

The following tools are required for this assembly

1 x Socket Set - 13mm Spanner

1 x Cross Head Screwdriver (also known as a Phillips)



CAUTION WITH ASSEMBLY

Some stages of this Bed Assembly will require two people to hold and lift components that maybe heavy.



This product takes approximately 60 - 90 MINUTES to assemble with 2 PEOPLE.


The fittings pack contains SMALL ITEMS which should be KEPT AWAY FROM YOUNG CHILDREN.



FOR SLATTED SLATTED FRAME OPTION, FOLLOW STEPS BELOW FOR BISCUIT PLATFORM OPTION SKIP TO STEP 7


*We recommend flipping the slatted frames for easier access to bolt holes.

- **4.** Your slatted frame will arrive in two sections and are **required to be connected together** by following the next steps.
- **5.** On each of the points use **one** fixing bolt **two washers** and **one fixing nut** to secure the frame together.





6. Place the two brace bars onto the slatted frame at each end. These are fixed by the allen key bolts supplied in the bag.




TOP VIEW OF SLATTED FRAME

The hinge brackets will already be fixed into place.

Please Note: You are required to follow the steps as detailed to make sure that the bed is correctly set up.

Left Hand Bracket





- 1 . Remove the M8 Nut on position A
- 2 . Move the gas strut into the position ${f A}$
- 3 . Place the M8 Nut and tighten with 13mm Spanner

Right Hand Bracket

6.

- 1 . Remove the M8 Nut on position B •
- 2 . Move the gas strut into the position ${f B}$
- 3 . Place the M8 Nut and tighten with 13mm Spanner




** IF YOUR BED IS SUPPLIED WITH HIGH FOOTBOARD, YOU NEED TO SCREW THE SUPPLIED LEGS TO THE BOTTOM OF THE HEADBOARD & FOOTBOARD

Please Note: this step will require two people and requires lifting.

7. Connect the side rails to the **headboard** sliding the bolts into the brackets and tightening with spanner or appropriate socket set.


Then proceed to connect the footboard to both of the siderails by sliding the bolts into brackets and tightening with the correct size spanner.




**Do not tighten bolts to one side until step 7

FOOTBOARD






9. Connect the electric cables before placing the base boards into your bed.










12. Lower the **first** base board into place with the angled cut corners against the head board (as shown above).

Make sure that the cables from the motors are laying on the top of the base board and are not behind the hinge unit.

13. Lower the **second** base board into place with the angled cut corners against the head board (as shown below).









Please Note: this step will require two people and requires lifting.

14. With help, lower the slatted base onto the two rails (attached to the motorised hinge). **Make sure that the welded retaining brackets**

are at the headboard end.






Please make sure you thread this hole on each side. DO NOT USE the end two holes.

15. Using the $4 \times M8$ Bolts and Nuts, attach the slatted frame to each of the hinge brackets; $2 \times M8$ Bolts & Nuts to each hinge.

You will need to use a 13 mm spanner/ socket set in order to tighten each of the bolts.




YOUR BED WILL ONLY LOWER ONCE THE MATTRESS IS IN PLACE




Please Note: this step will require two people and requires lifting.

- **16.** Lower your mattress onto the slatted frame.
- ** Recommended mattress weight to be at least 45kg to allow for the pistons to work properly.



17. Plug in the power lead from the transformer and lower the bed.



18. Once tested, your bed is ready for use.



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plastic-based sheeting, as this will lead to damage caused by condensation.


Don't sit on the edge of your mattress. They are designed to have weight spread over the whole area.

Don't bend or roll your mattress, this can cause damage to the spring unit and tear the material.

> Don't walk or jump on your bed and please don't let children use it as a trampoline!

Once you and your new mattress have got to know each other, we recommend some maintenance tips to ensure your mattress lasts for as long as possible. These include rotating and/or turning over your mattress, cleaning your mattress, and airing it out.





Do not worry if hollows appear in the sleeping areas of your mattress. This is quite normal and is not a fault. Due to the top layers consisting of wool/silk and cotton, it is important that the mattress is kneaded to bring it back to its original condition each month. This will reduce the amount of natural settlement that will happen.
